There's plenty of information on how to look after your plants, but we often forget about the pot.

Here's some handy tips on how to keep your POT happy!

- Once home, remove all plastic/packaging from pot.
- Do not leave pots out in the weather with the plastic wrap on as this can affect the surface.
- Outdoor pots should have a drainage hole. It's important water is able to easily drain from the pot.
- This will keep both your pot and your plant happy and healthy!
- A patch of fibreglass fly screen can be placed over the drainage hole inside the pot to minimise soil particles from escaping.
- To help keep the drainage hole 'free', pots should be raised slightly using tiles positioned evenly beneath the pot, not covering drainage holes.
- Always use a good quality potting mix. Never use normal garden soil.
- If you are concerned about the impact of drainage onto tiles or pavers you should look at alternatives prior to planting.
- Choose the location for your plant carefully. Once planted, avoid lifting or moving a fibreglass pot.
